

15th UITM INTERNATIONAL SPORTS FIESTA RULES & REGULATION

CHESS

1. Rules

The competition will be held in accordance with the rules of FIDE (World Chess Federation) and general rules.

2. Eligibility

This tournament is by INVITATION ONLY. / Participation is open to all UNDERGRADUATES and POSTGRADUATES from universities, college and other institutes of higher education.

- 2.1 STUDENTS of UNIVERITIES
- 2.2 Each team may comprise a maximum number of 6 members from the same university. However, there must be at least 1 male player and 1 female player in each team.
- 2.3 Each University may register a maximum of two (2) teams

3. Event

- 3.1 Individual Event
- 3.2 Team Event

Team ranking is determined by accumulating the highest score from **four (4) team** members (inclusive of score from at least 1 male or female team member).

4. Format and System

- 4.1 UiSF Chess Championship will be conducted as **FIDE rated 9-round individual swiss** system with team tiebreak.
- 4.2 Time control is 90 minutes with 30 seconds increment from move 1.
- 4.3 All electronic devices (mobile phones, wrist watches and etc.) are banned in tournament hall.
- 4.4 Player from the same university will not be paired each other.

 - 6.1.2 Buchholz cut 1
 - 6.1.3 Sonnerborn-Berger
 - 6.1.4 Progressive Score

6.2 Team event

- 6.2.1 The aggregate ranking number of the players who contributing in team score. (The highest score from four (4) team members inclusive of score from at least 1 male or female team member)
- 6.2.2 Buchholz cut 1
- 6.2.3 Sonnerborn-Berger
- 6.2.4 Progressive Score

7. Appeal Committee

- 7.1 Appeal committee consists of:
 - 7.1.1 A Chairman appointed by the organizer.
 - 7.1.2 A Technical Chairman.
 - 7.1.3 Five (5) team representative that are not involved in the appeal
- 7.2 An appeal must be submitted in written immediately within 30 minutes after the match ended and accompanied by the official protest fee of RM500 (Ringgit Malaysia: FIVE HUNRED ONLY) cash as deposit. The fee is refundable only if the matter ruled in the favor of the protesting party.

8. Equipment

Chess set and Chess clock prescribed by the Technical Committee will be provided by the Organizing Committee

9. Prizes

The pizes of UiTM International Sports Fiesta will be provided by the Organizing Committee. Certificates of participation will be presented to all participants and officials of the games.

10. Clothes

All officials and players should be properly attired in the tournament hall. **Short pants**, short skirts and slippers are strictly NOT allowed.

11. Other Matter

In all others matter not covered by preceding rules, the decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final.
